Ananias and Sapphira Acts 4:31-5:11





The Story

The believers in the church in Jerusalem were like a big family. The believers were filled with the Holy Spirit. Each believer was filled with love for the others. They shared their possessions with those who were needy. Those who had land or houses sold them and brought the money to the apostles to give to those who were in need. Barnabas, a believer from the country of Cyprus, had land and sold it. He brought the money to the apostles to share with the needy.

You have not lied to men, but to God."

When Ananias heard these words, he fell down and died. Great fear came on all those who heard of these things. Some young men who were there rose up and wrapped Ananias in his robes, carried him out, and buried him.

About three hours later, Ananias's wife, Sapphira, came in, not knowing what had happened. Peter asked her, "Tell me, did you sell the land for this much?"

Sapphira answered, "Yes, for so much."

Then Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."

Immediately, Sapphira fell down at Peter's feet, struck dead by the power of God. The young men came in and found her dead. They carried her out and buried her by her husband.
